


Classic symmetry with a quarried cut, Limestone works as well with contemporary projects as it does with old-world aesthetics. Features precise grout lines.





Rough textured and irregularly shaped, Moss stone features relatively consistent color ranges primarily in warm earth tones. Well-suited to both standard width and wide grout lines.

Corners available. Diameter: 8" to 16" Thickness: 1½" to 2½"



Moss Ledge

Combining both small and large stones, Moss Ledge tightly packs irregular shapes to create an elemental blend. It features an earthy brown with sporadic rust highlights.

Corners available. Flats: 4" to 12" high by 6" to 20" long Thickness: 1½" to 2½"




